### CORONAVIRUS HOME SUPPORT SERVICE

ADCA is now providing support and food and prescription deliveries to people who are self-isolated or live alone whose family, friends or neighbours are unable to help. For those people needing support it is important that you get it from people you know or trust.

This ADCA service covers the four local parishes of Audlem, Buerton, Hankelow and Hatherton & Walgherton. We are working with the Parish Councils, Cheshire East Council, Audlem Medical Practice, Boots Chemists, Audlem Coop, the Lord Combermere and other local groups and churches

ADCA staff and volunteers continue to support the 80 older people and 100 carers we already work with as well as a growing number of new people who have referred themselves to us for help.
